
Swim, Bike, Run, and CURE CANCER!

One of my patients, Clayton, came in at the end of September with complaints of fatigue and "feeling cold." After some screening lab tests, I received a dreadful phone call about the results. Soon Clayton was sent to Lucile Packard Children's Hospital for further evaluation to confirm the diagnosis and begin chemotherapy. He is diagnosed with a rare type of leukemia called biphenotypic acute leukemia, and his initial hospital course was almost two months long since there isn't a clear treatment protocol for this rare leukemia. Clayton has shown so much courage and humor in dealing with his illness; I am truly inspired by his strength and courage. Clayton is now getting ready for bone marrow transplant in the near future after 4 months of chemotherapy.
